

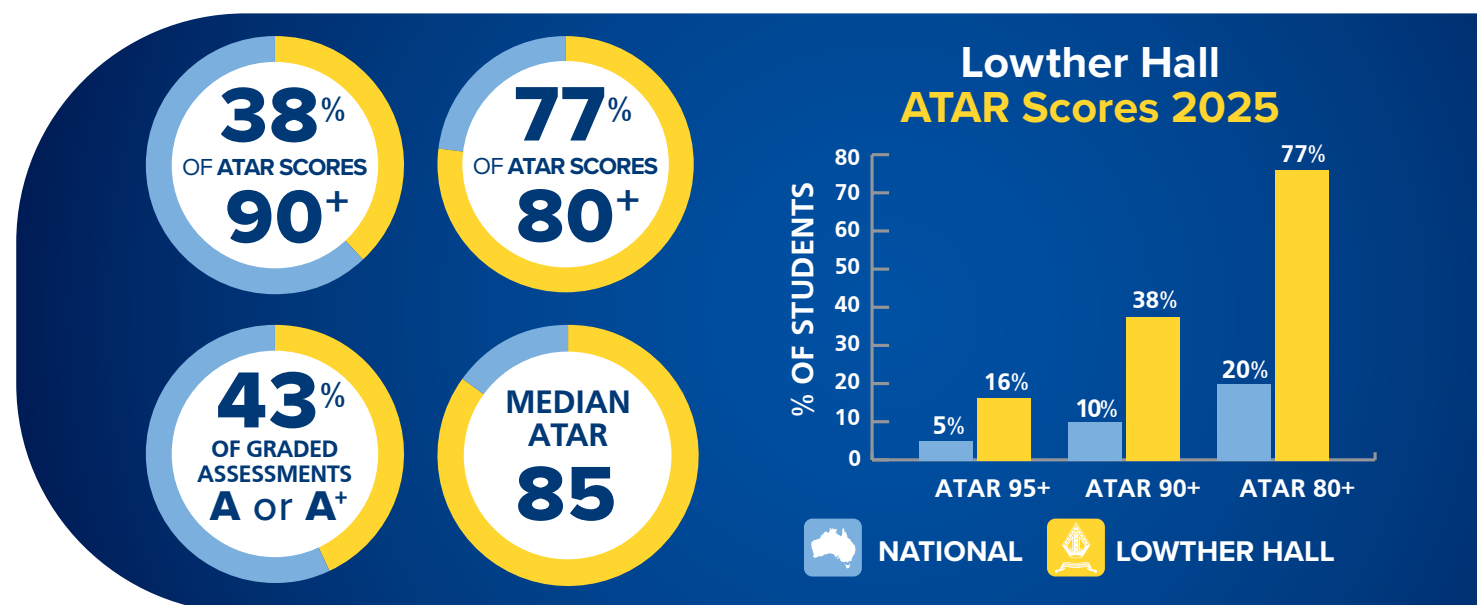


Congratulations to our 2025 VCE Students

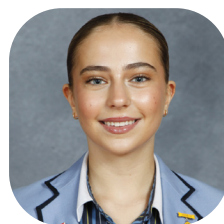
