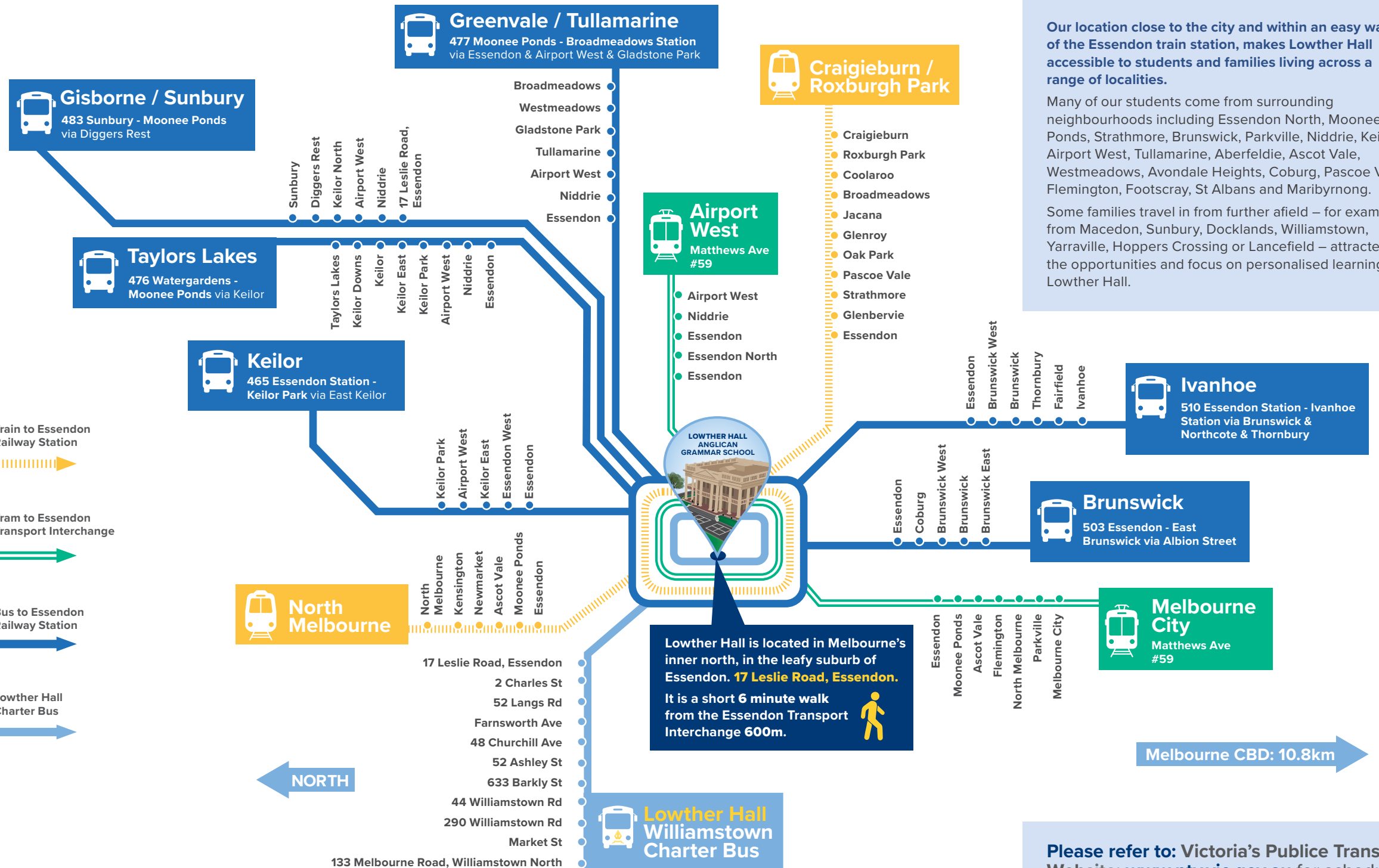
Walking School Bus

The Walking School Bus is a service that is provided in partnership between Lowther Hall and the Moonee Valley City Council.

It is designed to instil a habit of walking to school with a view to promoting a healthy lifestyle. Parents of girls in Prep to Year 6 can drop their daughter off at the corner of Mantell and Park streets, Moonee Ponds at 8.25am a number of mornings each week, where adult volunteers will safely supervise students as they walk with "the bus" to School.

Our location close to the city and within an easy walk of the Essendon train station, makes Lowther Hall accessible to students and families living across a range of localities.

Many of our students come from surrounding neighbourhoods including Essendon North, Moonee Ponds, Strathmore, Brunswick, Parkville, Niddrie, Keilor, Airport West, Tullamarine, Aberfeldie, Ascot Vale, Westmeadows, Avondale Heights, Coburg, Pascoe Vale, Flemington, Footscray, St Albans and Maribyrnong.

Some families travel in from further afield – for example from Macedon, Sunbury, Docklands, Williamstown, Yarraville, Hoppers Crossing or Lancefield – attracted by the opportunities and focus on personalised learning at Lowther Hall.
